# COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS **BOARD MEETING**

#### MINUTES

### October 12, 2016

The Columbia County Board of Commissioners met in scheduled session with Commissioner Henry Heimuller and Commissioner Earl Fisher, together with Sarah Hanson, County Counsel and Julie Stenberg, Acting Board Office Administrator. Commissioner Anthony Hyde was not present.

Commissioner Heimuller called the meeting to order and led the flag salute.

### **COMMISSIONER HEIMULLER COMMENTS:**

Commissioner Heimuller commented that it has been a busy week with Halloweentown events going on. He encouraged all to come down and enjoy those festivities that are taking place every weekend in October.

Last Thursday, he attended a NOHA meeting in Warrenton and they discussed how to retain and increase affordable housing in the northwest corner of the state. After that meeting, he drove to Seaside to inspect and tour a housing complex that is currently owned by Clatsop County Housing Authority. The property is for sale and NOHA is

going to reconsider asking that the property be given to them so that it can be used for affordable housing.

On Monday, he attended the Public Transportation Advisory meeting in Portland. Senator Johnson was there and discussion was held on public transportation statewide. Commissioner Elect Alex Tardif accompanied him to the meeting so that he could see and hear a little bit about what public transportation does for us in the State of Oregon and how our County participates.

He will be in Silverton on Thursday for the annual meeting of the Oregon Transportation Commission. As Chair of the NWACT, it is a requirement to report on what transportation issues are in our area.

On Friday, he will travel to Salem for the Association of Oregon Counties Health and Human Services committee meeting. He will then travel to Linn County in the afternoon for their affordable housing programs tour.

# **COMMISSIONER FISHER COMMENTS:**

Commissioner Fisher commented that on Monday, he attended the AOC meeting in Salem. One of those meetings had to do with a court facilities study. Recommendations were made for funding of courthouses and Columbia County is on the list for the year 2025.

Commissioner Hyde is not present as he had some minor surgery yesterday. Our very competent and long serving secretary Jan, is also recovering from surgery yesterday.

Our condolences go out to the gentleman that works for Lakeside Industries that had an accident on Apiary Rd. during a paving project. That accident seems to have occurred as a result of someone pulling out from following a pilot car on a corner and ran into the worker and a piece of equipment. Please - when you are in a construction zone, follow all of the rules.
