WHEREAS, at an election duly and regularly held on the 21st day of September, 1999, within Columbia County, State of Oregon, and within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed as hereinafter described, there was submitted to the electors thereof the question whether or not said territory should be annexed into the Columbia River People's Utility District pursuant to the provisions of ORS Chapter 261; and

WHEREAS, at the election so held 518 votes were cast in favor of annexation, and 164 votes were cast against annexation; and

WHEREAS, the annexation of the territory into the Columbia River People's Utility District received the affirmative vote of the majority of the votes cast at the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon, hereby does proclaim, declare and order that all of that part of Columbia County, State of Oregon, described as:

(a) that area in the City of Scappoose that was excluded from the Columbia River PUD when it was created, i.e., the area within the 1940 city limits of Scappoose, except those areas within the 1940 city limits of Scappoose which have been already annexed into the Columbia River PUD, as described in Exhibit 1 of the September 8, 1999, boundary determination hearing; and

(b) that area within what was then known as the Scappoose Drainage District (now known as the Scappoose Drainage Improvement Company) as it existed in 1940, except that the boundary of the area being considered for annexation along the Multnomah Channel is determined as the low water line on the left (west) bank of the Multnomah Channel as it is now, instead of the Government meander line on the left bank of the Willamette Slough (now referred to as the Multnomah Channel), as described in the order which created the Scappoose Drainage District, as described in Exhibit 1 of the September 8, 1999, boundary determination hearing

has been duly and legally annexed into the Columbia River People's Utility District under and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Oregon.
