


## Returning the Ballot



1. Place **only YOUR** voted ballot in the **ballot secrecy envelope** and seal the envelope.
2. Place the sealed secrecy envelope in the return envelope and seal the return envelope.
3. **SIGN** the voter's statement on the back of the return envelope. Your ballot will **NOT be counted if the envelope is not SIGNED.**

4. **Mail** or **deliver** (to an official drop box) the signed and sealed return envelope as soon as possible.
5. Your voted ballot **must be received by 8:00 p.m.** on Election Day or it will not be counted.
