POSITION: **BUILDING INSPECTOR 1 & 2 (PART-TIME)** This position is part-time, approximately 18 hours per week.

SALARY: Building Inspector 1: \$25.61-\$31.70; Building Inspector 2: \$30.99-\$38.35 both depending on experience. As a part time position, there are no benefits offered except PERS.

CLOSING: **OPEN UNTIL FILLED.** The County will consider applications as they are submitted and may close the recruitment at any time.

DUTIES: Inspect residential and/or commercial buildings and plans for compliance with State and County codes.

TO QUALIFY: Equivalent to high school graduation. Inspector 1: With additional college level course work in a related field and at least three years of related work experience. Inspector 2: With two years of college in a broad, specialized field plus five years of related work experience.

Must possess a valid driver's license and be insurable under the County's liability insurance.

Inspector 1: Certification by the State of Oregon as a C.A.B.O. one and two family dwelling structural and one and two family dwelling plans inspector and residential electrical and resident plumbing inspector, or the ability to obtain these certificates within six (6) months of employment.

Inspector 2: Must possess, at time of hire: A Level Structural Inspector, A Level Mechanical Inspector, One and Two Family Dwelling Structural and Mechanical Inspector. International Code Council (ICC) Certifications may substitute for the required certifications only if in possession of Oregon Inspection Certificate (OIC). Additional certifications are desirable.

TO APPLY: Applicants MUST submit the Columbia County application form. The application form must be filled out completely for consideration and the instructions listed online for submittal followed correctly. Incomplete or unsigned applications will not be accepted. A thorough background check, including criminal history, will be conducted of final candidates.
